Full Truckload (FTL) vs. Less-Than Truckload (LTL)

- » FTL freight shipping is the action of moving freight from one shipper to a single destination. FTL is great when you want a dedicated truck for your goods.
- » Less-than-Truckload (LTL): Combines separate shipments from multiple businesses to fill one truckload.

Hours of service regulations for drivers

(Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration)

- » When planning shipments, it is important to factor in the hours-of-service regulations.
- » Drivers have a 14-hour consecutive work limit.
- » During this time, they are allowed to drive one truck up to 11 hours total only after 10 consecutive hours off duty.
- » There is a 60/70 hour limit rule, which says drivers can restart a 7/8 consecutive day driving period after being off duty 34 or more consecutive hours.
